Class 2. Elementary 42 (2008) Warm up	Warm up class. Entries may be limited and will be taken on a first come first served basis. Entries/fees on a separate form/cheque to team entry.	£12 non LDRC members £10 LDRC members
Class 3. Senior Prelim Team	Area Qualifier. Qualifying teams qualify for the National Championships. Teams of 4 riders, with 3 scores to count. Tests are: Class 3A: Prelim 2 (2016) Class 3B: Prelim 12 (2005) Class 3C: Prelim 14 (2006) Class 3D: Prelim 18 (2012)	£60 per team £15 for individual entry – all team members are automatically entered into the individual competition
Class 4. Senior Open Team	Area Qualifier. Qualifying teams qualify for the National Championships. Teams of 4 riders, with 3 scores to count. Tests are: Class 4A: Novice 24 (2010) Class 4B: Novice 28 (2008) Class 4C: Novice 39 (2010) Class 4D: Elementary 40 (2010)	£60 per team £15 for individual entry – all team members are automatically entered into the individual competition
Class 5. Senior and Junior Intro	Area Qualifier. Individual competition. This class will be split into senior and junior sections. Class 5A: Intro C (2016) Senior Class 5B: Intro C (2016) Junior	£15 per individual
Class 6. – Senior pick a test	Area Qualifier. Individual competition. Medium 69 (2005) or Advanced Medium 91 (2016)	£15 per individual
Class 7. – Senior Riding test	Area Qualifier. Qualifying teams qualify for the National Championships. Team of 4 riders, two to ride prelim 13 and two to ride Novice 27. 7A: Prelim 13 (2006) 7B: Novice 27 (2007)	£60 per team £15 for individual entry – all team members are automatically entered into the individual competition

Class 8. – Junior Riding test	Area Qualifier. Qualifying teams qualify for the National Championships. All team members ride the same test. Prelim 2 (2016)	£60 per team £15 for individual entry – all team members are automatically entered into the individual competition
Class 9. – Senior and Junior Pairs	Area Qualifier. Pairs qualify for the National Championships. This class will be split into senior and junior sections. Class 9A: BRC Pairs 5 (2014) Senior Class 9B: BRC Pairs 5 (2014) Junior	£15 per pair
Class 10. – Junior Dressage	Area Qualifier. Qualifying teams qualify for the National Championships. Teams of 4 riders, with 3 scores to count. Tests are: Class 10A: Prelim 7 (2002) Class 10B: Prelim 12 (2005) Class 10C: Prelim 18 (2002) Class 10D: Novice 24 (2010)	£60 per team £15 for individual entry – all team members are automatically entered into the individual competition
Class 11. – Junior Elementary	Area Qualifier. Individual competition. Elementary 43 (2006)	£15 per individual

A PHOTOGRAPHER and CATERING will be in attendance during the competition

Eligibility for all classes can be found in the current BRC Handbook. All competitors for qualifying classes must be a member of BRC and be on their database. Anyone failing to meet the eligibility criteria will be disqualified and informed by BRC HQ when the results are processed.

Preliminary Entries:

All entrants must submit a pre-entry to BRC at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier (**26th June 2021**). Pre-entries can be made via the pre-entry link on the BRC website. Late pre-entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge if space permits. Late entries cannot be guaranteed and so therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been gained.

Once the pre-entry has been made, an area entry must be made via the details below:

Rosettes will be awarded for arena placings, 1st to 6th. In the warm up classes, no differentiation will be made between juniors and seniors.

Declaration forms should be sent by team managers to area18.officialsteward@gmail.com 24 hours prior to the competition start.

BRIDLE/SADDLE CLOTH NUMBERS MUST BE WORN ON BOTH SIDES OF THE HORSE

This competition will run under BRC Rules, anyone in attendance will be bound by the BRC Code of Conduct. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition – please see the current BRC Handbook and also the BRC Rule Amendments and Changes Document which can be found on the BRC website. Numbers to qualify as per Appendix 10 are dependent on Appendix 9 in the current BRC Handbook.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason and rescheduled within 21 days, the close of pre-entry will remain. If the qualifier is rescheduled for more than 21 days after the original date, entries will re-open. Late entry fees will not be refunded. Eligibility is taken from the Friday before the qualifier, regardless of rescheduling. Pre-entries that cannot attend the new date may be issued a credit note but the Team Manager must inform the BRC office in writing before the cut-off date which the area will be informed of upon rescheduling.

Hats

All hats must have a visible BRC/BE/PC hat tag in place before they are worn on the showground, to show that they meet the current safety standards. For up to date hat rules please see the current BRC Handbook.

Equine Flu Vaccinations

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook. There is also a checking device on the BRC website. If you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518. Please bring your horses' vaccination certificates/passports with you. If no certificate/passport is produced on request it could incur disqualification and it is illegal to travel your horse to a competition without it.

This event will abide to current COVID-19 Government guidelines. Please do not linger once you have finished riding. Test sheets and rosettes can be posted to nominated riding club representatives or team managers. Please ensure these details are included on the entry form.

Showground rules

- LDRC will not tolerate any verbal or physical abuse of its members, competitors, spectators or animals and reserves the right to ask any person deemed to be behaving inappropriately to leave the showground.
- Any animal behaving in a manner which may pose a danger to other attendees may be asked to leave the ring / show ground – no refund of entry fees will be made.
- Stallions must display a stallion disc at all times.
- Horses or ponies must be at least 4 years of age to compete.
- A child protection trained member of the LDRC committee is available all day – contact the secretary.
- Horses must not be unattended tied to the outside of vehicles. No haynets to be tied to the outside of vehicles.

- All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and all fouling must be removed .
- Directions of any steward or representative of LDRC must be followed, failure to do so may result in elimination and / or being asked to leave a class / the show ground. No refund of entry fees will be made.
- The judge's decision and that of the BRC Official Steward is final. Any objections must be made in accordance with BRC rule G14l.
- Human First aid will be available – contact the secretary.
- LDRC, the BHS, BRC and the landowners, accept no responsibility for accident, injury, loss or damage to any horse, vehicles, riders, grooms, spectators etc. while in attendance at this event.
